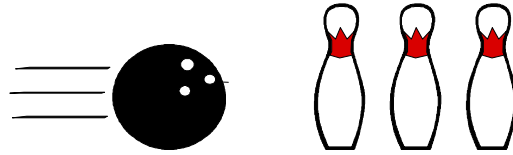

COST: \$40/person (includes \$20 donation to benefit *Sweet Dreamzzz* in memory of Kelly J. Price and other dear friends who supported this event and, sadly, have left us; three games, bowling shoes (if you need them), door prizes, and dinner: roasted chicken, meatballs with gravy, vegetable lasagna, oven roasted potatoes, green beans almondine, tossed salad, rolls and butter, cookies and brownies, pop and coffee; cash bar

Bowling and Prizes: \$30/person; or Dinner and Prizes: \$35/person

FORMAT: Actual scores with 80% handicap. While bowling, two strike ball games will be played. First, after bowling the first strike of the afternoon (not every strike), player picks a prize from one of the "Lucky Strike" prize tables. Second, during the second game - if a green pin appears as the headpin and the player strikes, player wins a lotto ticket!

Highest actual series plus handicap for men and women wins \$50 and traveling trophy; second place champs for men and women win \$30.
